

Big Picture Old Testament



Lots of pieces

Need them all – preservation of each jot and tittle
 (De 4:2; Ps 12:6-7; Pr 30:5-6; Mt 5:18; Re 22:18-19)
 Not all Bibles are the same. Some are missing key pieces
 (i.e. Acts 8:37, Mar 16:9-20)

One way to do it right. What did the Author intend?

No private interpretation (2Pe 1:20-21)
 Must be rightly divided (2Ti 2:15)
 Takes time and hard work (Isa 28:10)

Self-interpreting. Search, sort, and compare.

Searching: Joh 5:39; Acts 17:11;
 Comparing: 1Co 2:13; Joh 6:63

Find edges, corners, colors (i.e. key concepts) – people, places, events, and times

Gets easier as pieces fall into place. What seems right at first may turn out to be wrong later

A blind man would have a hard time doing a puzzle. Mt 13:13 Joh 12:40 2Co 4:3-4

2Ti 3:16 - profitable
 2Ti 2:15 - to study, rightly dividing
 2Ti 2:2 - teach others to teach others

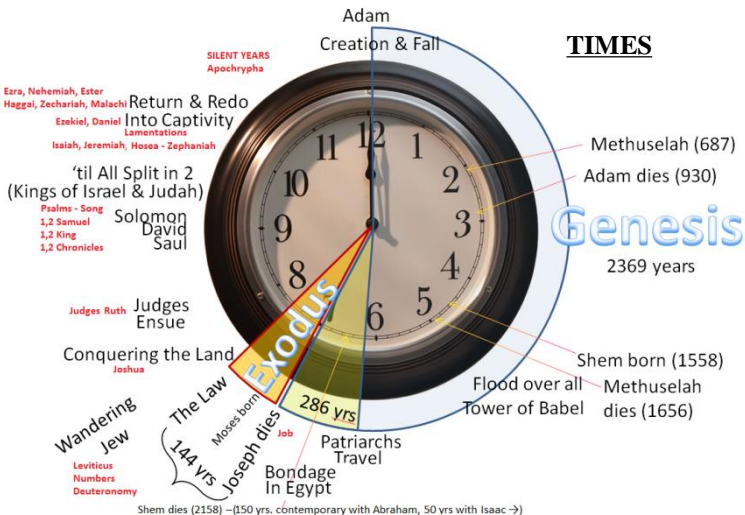
