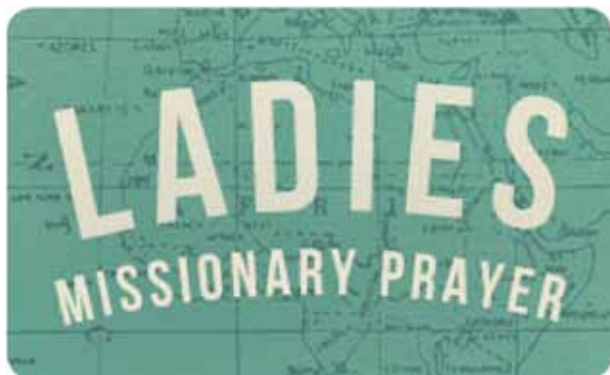


WALK FOR LIFE
