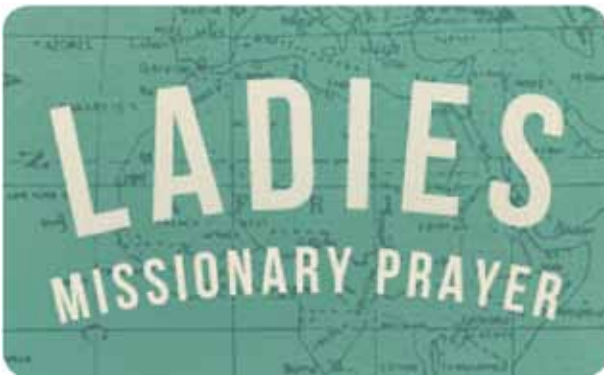
**GOSPEL MUSIC HYMN SING**

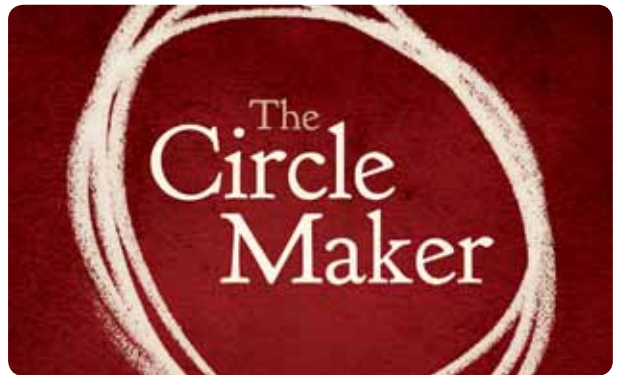

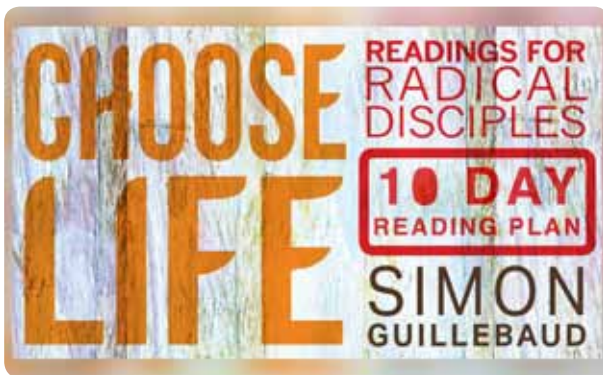
